

Rules For Triple S Seniors Golf Club Championship 2024

1. Every club member in good standing who has played at least four (4) home rounds is eligible to compete. Triple S Seniors will pay the entrance fee for each member who actively declares their intent to play.
2. The Club Championship Tournament shall be contested during the regular Triple S weekly home rounds at La Mirada Golf Course in August and September (8/28, 9/4, 9/11, 9/18, and 9/25). This tournament will produce a one Gross Club Champion, one Net Club Champion, and multiple Flight Champions. (The La Mirada Golf course plans to perform maintenance on their greens starting October 7 – so a one-week cushion is provided in case of weather and/or other delays).
3. In addition to prize money paid to both the Club Gross Champion and the Club Net Champion the Triple S Seniors will pay 2025 club dues for those two winners. In addition, the entry fee for the Gross club Champion to play in the annual Tournament of Champions will be paid by the club. And both of these two winners will receive trophies from the club signifying their achievement.
4. Players can compete from either the red tees, or white tees in this tournament. Players must declare their tee box preference before playing the first round and then must use that same tee box for the duration of the tournament. Only golfers playing from the white tees are eligible to be Club Gross Champion.
5. The tournament is comprised of five stroke play rounds. Of which only the player's best two of the first four rounds will be used for scoring. (If players participate in each of the first four rounds, then the two worst net score rounds of those first four will be eliminated.) **Players must participate in the fifth and final round to be eligible to win.** Each Flight Champion will be determined by the total of the best two net scores of the first four rounds and the net score of the final round within each flight. The lowest gross score total will be declared the Club Champion. The Club Champion will represent the Triple S Senior Golf Club in the SCGA Club Champion Tournament. The Club Champion is not eligible to also be a Flight Champion.
6. Tie Breaking Rules:
 - A tie for first place for Gross Club Champion will result in a playoff between all tied players.
 - Ties for first place in the Net Championship will be decided by card-off between all tied players.
 - Any ties throughout any of the multiple flights in any level will stand as ties, and will not be resolved. If there is a two-way tie for first place, in a flight, both players are awarded 1st place and split the first and second place money. The next place would be 3rd. The same procedure will be used for all ties except 5th place. If a tie for 5th place occurs, a card-off will be used to determine a sole winner.
7. In the event of a tie after completing the final round for the gross club championship, all of the tied players will go back out to replay hole #18 as a playoff hole. If the tie persists after that hole, the remaining tied players will go back out and play hole #18 until the tie is broken.
8. All games must be played on the scheduled tournament dates. No alternative date rounds will be allowed.
9. Players will be assigned into flights determined by their handicap on the first round of play. Players will remain within that assigned flight regardless of changes in their handicap during the tournament. The number of flights will be determined by how many players register for the tournament with a goal of having as equal number of players per flight as possible.
